Application Process:

Step 1. Explore all UCC Educational Programs have to offer – visit our website www.bgcsedu.org

Step 2. Learn more about UCC schools! Please check our website for dates and time to attend our open houses.

Step 3. Complete and submit the “6 wks to 4 yrs. old Educational Programs pre-application”, should be given to our school offices or email it to uccenrollment@bgcsedu.org

Step 4. Attend an information meeting. All 6 weeks- 4 years pre-applications for the 2022-23 school year will be contacted by a UCC Enrollment Representative to schedule an intake appointment. The original birth certificate and other important documentation must be provided during this meeting.

UCC Head Start: Head Start and Early Head Start Program are free, federally funded programs designed to promote school readiness for children from low-income families. We provided comprehensive services, including health, nutrition and parent involvement.

Wisconsin Shares with the Wisconsin Department of Children and Families: The Wisconsin Shares Child Care Subsidy Program supports families by funding a portion of the cost of child care while the parents are working or participating in an approved activity. Wisconsin Shares Child Care Program Participants receiving the **ADEQUATE** amount of childcare hours, do not pay tuition.

UCC Scholarship Tuition. Six weeks - K4 tuition is not funded fully by the State of Wisconsin, there are fees associated with those levels. Our enrollment specialist will share those details with you as well as options for payments during your information meeting.
